

Fall 2025 ARES SET – EPA Results

OVERVIEW

This year's SET focused on connectivity and outreach. There are SET activities for ARES teams to connect, for ARES leadership to describe their team's ability to connect with other teams and services and to reach out to other hams to join the ARES team. The SET was scheduled for the weekend of Oct 4 and 5.

- 1) Alert and Readiness
- 2) Interconnectivity

Alert and Readiness

ARES teams were encouraged to perform an activation and hold an emergency net.

Interconnectivity

ARES relies on many other Emcomm related services to perform our mission. ECs were asked to complete a brief form describing their team's ability to use these related services and how third parties can connect with the team. The results are compiled here and distributed throughout EPA as a resource for all ARES teams to communicate with one another.

Outreach

ARRL provides a tool for interested hams to find local ARES groups. ECs were asked to register their group and if already registered, to inspect the registration for any changes.

TPRFN Messaging

ARES teams were asked to send a readiness bulletin using the TPRFN packet network. Only one bulletin per group is required but others are welcome.

TPRFN is included in this SET to increase awareness of this resource.

TPRFN RESULTS

In Eastern PA we have access to The Packet Radio RF Forwarding Network (TPRFN). It covers the entire east coast with VHF and HF BBS nodes that are linked by RF. It is a reliable Emcomm resource for internet and phone system outages.

For the SET, participants were asked to post a packet bulletin to the TPRFN. Many participants also sent Winlink messages via TPRFN

Glenn Allison N3MEL (Chester co EC and TPRFN lead) provided an ICS-309 Log of the exercise TPRFN messaging.

FYI. I attach a IC 211 check in list for SET Simplex test in DELCO Saturday. Note all the Delaware hospitals were on the air on 146.550 and were dead full quieting into Delco. The state HQ for DEMA in Smyrna, DE was on the air and Dead full quieting into Delco. Farthest contact was likely the Cape May, NJ station or maybe the Glen Burnie, MD station on 146.520. Berks county was on as well and very good signal into Media, PA. Back in the day we had PEMA Eastern area on the air but I did not hear any activity from PEMA Saturday.

We will be expanding the capabilities of the Delco Fire Station 73 amateur station in the next 6 months to include HF radios and packet node repeater from high profile antennas so as to be in place and immediately available in a situation which presents itself. We also have Delco 700/800 MHz and UHF Public Safety radios to relay necessary messages to the Delco EOC in any event in which that capability is actually warranted.
